



Holy Moly Prayer Cards for Parents

The edifying messages in the Motherwise Holy Moly Cards for Parents cards can be carried in a pocket, wallet or stuck to the refrigerator with magnets so they will be in plain view of the intended party whenever they are hungry. Print an extra copy and share it with your friends who have teens.

Look for the card game coming soon. A full deck required in order to play.

Easy printing and assembly directions:

Print this on regular paper in landscape setting (Use card stock if you want it to last more than a day).

Cut out on the dotted lines.

Fold in half, *vertically*.

Glue the left and right (front and back) sections together. Tape is okay too.

Read, enjoy, share with a friend.

Praise Be! It's A Cliché Revival!

All raise in praise from the cliché COMA! Yes, the four letter formula with the power to break it down and tell it like it is. Like Lazarus, you children in the dark will see the light. Heed the messages behind the C, O, M, and A and their saving power. They lay bare the sweet fruit that is ripe for the picking - the wisdom of those who had to learn the hard way. I wait in joyful hope for them to perform miracles!

As an example, I give you:

C = Cliché: Why buy the cow when you can get the milk for free?

O = Origin: Years ago, families had milk cows. You had to get up early, clean barns, feed and care for the cow, and milk it again at night. But extra milk could be sold. Other families found it easier

to buy this extra milk than to own their own cow.
M = Meaning: Other families (some people) will find it easier to buy this extra milk (shack up) rather than have the trouble of owning their own cow (get married).
A = Application: Don't get milked.

In closing, let us say:

Oh pearls of wisdom, precious and fair, help us to teach those who just don't care. Provide us alternate text to say, "I told you so" in a more diplomatic way. Call them from the COMA, and awaken their senses, as we use this simple formula to hide our pretenses. For judgment will be swift and we fear it, and when it comes to troubles you brought on yourself, most people don't really want to hear it. *Again.*
